Early Childhood Screening is a quick and simple check of each child's growth and development.

The purpose of this screening is to identify learning or health needs your child may have in the areas of hearing, vision, growth and general development prior to starting school. Early intervention can enhance growth and development. This is not a screening to determine kindergarten readiness.

This appointment should be scheduled as soon as possible after your child's third birthday.

Rochester Public Schools offers this screening at Northrup Community Education Center to children at least 3 years of age.
