Questions you might have: Winter Camp 2021

What precautions will you be taking with COVID-19?

Masks will be required at all times unless outside or while eating. We will do our best to social distance, but it cannot be guaranteed in all settings. We will be providing sanitizing wipes and hand sanitizer for host homes.

Is there a virtual option?

Yes, students will be able to join in for worship, sessions, and small group discussions virtually. They can also opt in for outdoor activities. The cost is the same for both options.

What does the cost cover?

T-shirt, breakfast, lunch and dinner both days, transportation during the day, all activities

Will my student need to bring extra money for anything?

No, everything they need will be covered.

Who are the host homes?

Host homes are trusted CCC attendees who have been through our screening process.

What will meals look like?

Light breakfast options will be available for students when they arrive to their host homes. Lunch and dinner will be brought from various restaurants to the host homes. Food will not be prepared at the host homes.

Is this overnight?

No, we will not be having an overnight element. Students will be required to be picked up from their host homes at the end time and can return in the morning at the designated start time.

How will students be transported during the day?

For rides that will be 15 minutes or less, designated adult leaders will drive students in their personal vehicles. For rides that are more than 15 minutes students, will be transported to the church by leaders and then taken by bus to designated location. If you are uncomfortable will your student riding in a car with others, parents are free to transport their own students.

Will I have to transport my student anywhere?

You will be responsible for getting your student to their host home at the start of the day and picking them up at the end of the day. (See schedule for times).

How are students going to be grouped?

Students will be grouped by their LifeGroups (grade and gender) to the best of our ability. Depending on current guidelines we may have to split groups if there are more students in a group than are allowed to meet together in one space.

Is middle school and high school combined?

Middle school and high school will be combined for worship and main sessions. High school will have additional breakout sessions.

What does my student need to bring?

Bible, Pen, Notebook/Journal, Winter Gear (gloves, snow pants, jackets, hat, etc.), and a good attitude
